

Dear Parade Entrant,

Our team has been hard at work putting together what we think will be an exciting and memorable event for all Porsche enthusiasts, their families and our sponsors. Everything you need to know about the Parade is on the official website, parade2010.pca.org. You can continue to sign up for the competitive events, banquets, tours and more until June 23rd. Just visit pca.org and edit your online registration.

Welcome Tent

Your first stop should be the Welcome Tent. There you will receive information on where to park, get your car washed and more. The Welcome Tent will be located in the NE corner of the Pheasant Run parking lot starting at noon on Friday, July 2^{nd} .

Check-in-- St. Charles Room

Check-in hours are: Saturday, July 3rd 8 am - 11 am, and 2 pm - 5 pm

At Check-in you will receive your name badges, car numbers, banquet tickets, Parade binder and goodie bag. Each entrant, co-entrant and family member must go through Check-in and sign the insurance waiver in order to receive their name badge. Badges will not be given to a family member.

Beginning Sunday morning, entrant packets will be available at the Parade Concierge desk.

If you are competing in the Concours, you MUST Check-in on Saturday to receive your number and judging sheets. This is your entry pass to get onto the Concours site. There will be no exceptions!

Concours Prep

- The indoor, air conditioned carpeted prep area is in the Expo Center directly across the street from the Pheasant Run Resort. It will be available beginning 10 am on July 1st.
- Though the lighting is good, it is recommended that you bring additional lighting and extension cords
- There will be no spray painting in the prep area. All spray painting must be completed outside and 100 feet from any cars. There will be no volatile liquids permitted inside the Expo Center.
- The gas tank level in all indoor prep vehicles can NOT exceed ¼ tank.
- All batteries must be disconnected after parking in the indoor prep area.
- Plastic or cardboard must be placed under every vehicle.
- The truck and trailer parking will be adjacent to the indoor prep area.
- There will be two car wash areas: (1) adjacent to the Expo Center in the Truck and Trailer parking lot and (2) at the Gallery Hall (farthest resort building west of the main entrance).



Concours

- Any requests for classification changes must be completed by 11:00 am Saturday, July 3rd.
- All judged cars must display their entry numbers in the center of the windshield to be admitted onto the Concours site. It is not necessary for judged cars to affix the side numbers until after the event
- The times for staging your car class will be given at Check-in.
- All judged cars must be driven onto the Concours field.

Porsche Corral

All cars must be placed in the Corral by 10:00 am and remain until 3:00 pm.

Parade Kids

At check-in Parade Kids will receive your Parade Kid's Goodie Bag, T-shirt and schedule for the week.

Babysitting

PCA Group Babysitting will be provided during Concours Banquet on July 5 and Victory Banquet on July 9. We are offering dinner, karaoke and Wii from 6 pm-11:00 pm in Preservation Hall A. If you require private babysitting, please call 630-248-7777.

Kids Events and Activities

There will be over 20 events for Parade Kids and 20 events for Teens/Young Adults. Please get your schedules at check-in. Schedules also provide a listing of family-friendly sites to visit in St. Charles and Chicago. Make sure to attend the Kid's Meet and Greet at the Welcome Party! Also, wear your Parade Kid's T-shirts to the Autocross Banquet...we will be recognizing our Porsche kids on that night, July 8.
